- Use of district heating for heating and hot water
- Local electricity from Interlaken, 100 % environmentally friendly Swiss hydropower
- Use of water from the river Aare to cool down our Auditorium eco-friendly
- Solar energy using solar panels on the historic building is currently being planned
- Of course, this also includes all the usual measures in the catering sector, such as regional and seasonal purchasing, short transport routes, avoidance of food waste and consistent waste separation
